## Please Register Now for the 2021-2022 Academic Year

December and January are the open enrollment months for students in and out of our District for the 2021-22 school year. This enrollment period is in accordance with an agreement between the school districts of Humboldt County.

- Families with students who are already attending Garfield School District will need to renew each of their student's Inter-district Transfer Agreements with their district of residence by January 31, 2021.
- Families new to Garfield School District or with students who will be attending for the first time in the fall will need to submit a request for an Inter-district Transfer from their district of residence and submit a Garfield Registration Form.

## Classroom Highlights

The Early Primary Class will begin a unit exploring science. We will learn what science is, what it means to be a scientist, learn about our five senses and then use them to make observations as we investigate light and sound.

The Middle Primary Class afternoon hangouts have been really successful this week. The students are sharing special items, playing together, and enjoying a chance to just talk freely about their interests. During the week of January 18th, I am looking forward to lessons and activities about Martin Luther King Jr. Every year students amaze me with how much they already know about him and I look forward to discussions about this special and heroic individual.

The Upper Elementary Class will be participating in inquiry-based Passion Projects this month. These projects will give students an opportunity to look at the big wide world around them and explore their own unique interests in a structured and supported way. This project based learning structure coined "Genius Hour" will replace the virtual Humboldt County Science Fair projects this year in distance learning for most students. However, any family who would like to do a traditional experiment as their passion project may work with Mrs. Kelley for specifics to participate in the virtual County fair. We are excited about these Passion Projects as a learning model that promotes inquiry, research, creativity, and project based learning.
