## **Absences and Tardies**

It is important to your child's academic and social development that they attend school regularly and on time. Every classroom begins the day promptly at 8:30. Arriving a little bit early gives children time to put their belongings away and get settled in for the day. Every classroom begins the day with a Morning Meeting. Morning Meeting is an integral part of our daily program and front loads students with information about the day ahead. Children who miss this piece enter the classroom at a disadvantage because they miss critical information about what is happening that day. Please make it a priority to arrive on time, thus ensuring a smooth morning transition and successful day for your child. If your child is tardy, meaning they arrive after the school bell has rung, be sure to have your child check in at the office.

If your child is unable to attend school, please contact the office and provide the reason for your child's absence. Teachers appreciate an email as well for planning purposes. **If your child is going to be absent for 3 or more consecutive school days, it is in everyone's best interest to request an independent study packet.** Independent studies keep your child from falling behind and, if adequately completed, may count as attendance. An email to Kathy and your child's teacher ahead of time are most helpful.

## Report Cards and Parent-Teacher Conferences

The end of the 1st Trimester is this Thursday, November 9th. Teachers will be sending home report cards on Monday, November 13th. Additionally, teachers will be hosting Parent Conferences during the week before Thanksgiving break, from November 13th-17th. Expect to see signups for family conference slots arriving in your inbox this week.

Conferences offer a unique opportunity to meet and collaborate with your child's teacher regarding your child's progress. Here are some ideas for making the most of your conference time:

### Ask the teacher:

- Any questions you have about the report card.
- What are my child's strengths?
- What are areas needing more support?
- How does my child get along with classmates?
- Is my child's ability and work meeting expectations?
- What can I/we do at home to support my/our child ?
